

SECTION 00440 - BID CONDITIONS
OPWC ASSISTED CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

ARTICLE 1 GENERAL

1.01 This project is funded in part by the Ohio Public Works Commission. As such, the provisions of the Ohio Administrative Code 123:2-3-02 regarding Equal Employment Opportunity on State Construction Contracts and State-assisted Construction Contracts, and the Ohio Administrative Code 123:2-3-02 regarding Equal Employment Opportunity and Female Utilization Goals are applicable to this project, and each Contractor will be required to comply in all aspects to the provisions of said executive orders.

1.02 The attached document entitled “State of Ohio Equal Employment Opportunity Requirements and Bid Conditions for OPWC-Assisted Construction Projects” is to be regarded as an integral component of the Bidder’s response.

ARTICLE 2 REQUIREMENTS

2.01 The Bidder must, as a part of his response:

- A. elect one of the two Bidder’s Affirmative Action Requirements;
- B. adopt the Bidder’s EEO Covenants; and
- C. complete the Bidder’s Certification.

2.02 The Bidder must submit a copy of a valid Certificate of Compliance for Equal Employment Opportunity purposes prior to the execution of a contract.

A. Failure to complete the required sections of the “State of Ohio Equal Employment Opportunity Requirements and Bid Conditions for OPWC-Assisted Construction Projects” may cause the Bidder’s proposal to be rejected as being non-responsive to the State’s Equal Employment Opportunity Requirements and in non-compliance with the State Equal Employment Opportunity Bid Conditions.

2.03 The Bidder, by submission of his/her Bid for the Project, affirms their compliance with the following Ohio Public Works Commission Proposal Notes as set forth in the attached document entitled “Ohio Public Works Commission Bidding Requirements”. These proposal notes address, but are not limited to, the following items:

- A. Steel Products Made in the United States;
- B. Prevailing Wages on State Projects with No Federal-Aid;
- C. Unresolved Finding For Recovery
- D. Ohio Workers’ Compensation Coverage;

- E. Drug-Free Workplace Program
- F. Ohio Preference
- G. Bid Guaranty
- H. Ohio Ethic's Law
