ARTICLE 1 PROPOSAL RECIPIENT

1.01 Proposals will be received until 10:00 A.M., local time, October 15, 2019.

1.03 The undersigned Proposer proposes and agrees, if this Proposal is accepted, to enter into an Agreement with Owner in the form included in the Bidding Documents to perform all Work as specified or indicated in the Bidding Documents for the prices and within the times indicated in this Proposal and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.

ARTICLE 2 PROPOSER'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

2.01 Proposer accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Instructions to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid security. This Proposal will remain subject to acceptance for 60 days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Proposer may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

2.02 Proposer will sign and deliver the required number of counterparts of the Agreement with the bonds, insurance certificates, and other documents required by the Bidding Requirements within 10 days after the Owner's Notice of Award.

ARTICLE 3 PROPOSER'S REPRESENTATIONS

3.01 In submitting this Proposal, Proposer represents that:

A. Proposer has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, the other related data identified in the Bidding Documents, and the following Addenda, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

B. Proposer has visited the Site and become familiar with and is satisfied as to the general, local and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.

C. Proposer is familiar with and is satisfied as to all federal, state and local Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress and performance of the Work.

D. Proposer has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or contiguous to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions in or relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at or contiguous to the Site (except Underground Facilities) which have been identified in SC-4.02, and (2) reports and drawings of Hazardous Environmental Conditions that have been identified in SC-4.06.

E. Proposer has obtained and carefully studied (or accepts the consequences for not doing so) all additional or supplementary examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies and data concerning conditions (surface, subsurface and Underground Facilities) at or contiguous to the Site which may affect cost, progress, or performance of the Work or which relate to any aspect of the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Proposer, including applying the specific means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction expressly required by the Bidding Documents to be employed by Proposer, and safety precautions and programs incident thereto.

F. Proposer does not consider that any further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Proposal for performance of the Work at the price(s) bid and within the times and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.

G. Proposer is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.

H. Proposer has correlated the information known to Proposer, information and observations obtained from visits to the Site, reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, and all additional examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, and data with the Bidding Documents.

I. Proposer has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Proposer has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Proposer.

J. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance of the Work for which this Proposal is submitted.

K. Proposer will submit written evidence of its authority to do business in the state where the Project is located not later than the date of its execution of the Agreement.

ARTICLE 4 FURTHER REPRESENTATIONS

4.01 Proposer further represents that:

A. This Proposal is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any agreement or rules of any group, association, organization or corporation;

B. Proposer has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Proposer to submit a false or sham Proposal;

C. Proposer has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding;

D. Proposer has not sought by collusion to obtain for itself any advantage over any other Proposer or over Owner.

6.03 Proposer accepts the provisions of the Agreement as to liquidated damages in the event of failure to complete the Work within the Contract Times.
