Student(s) can maintain multi-year scholarships if they continue to fulfill program requirements.

Recipients and/or applicants may also be eligible for mentoring opportunities.

## I. Purpose:

To provide financial assistance to Black/African descent students enrolled in a Civil Engineering program at an accredited Ohio College or University.

## II. Parameters:

- Four (4) \$2,500.00 scholarships annually to a student of Black/African descent enrolled in a Civil Engineering program at an accredited Ohio College or University.

- Renewable, upon reapplication by the student, for up to three academic years.
- Scholarship money is paid directly to the College or University prior to the start of the academic year.

## III. Application Timeline:

We consider applications on a rolling basis. You are encouraged to apply as soon as possible to be considered for awards beginning in January, May, or August. The application is a multi-step process.

## IV. Minimum Requirements for Renewal Selection Criteria:

Scholarships intended for full-time students entering or attending a Civil Engineering program at an accredited Ohio College or University.
