

Edwin B. Hogan Memorial Scholarship

A \$5,000 scholarship will be given to a Black/African student in the civil engineering, architecture, surveying, or planning fields focused on community involvement.

To be eligible for this scholarship program, applicants must be of Black/African descent, be enrolled in an accredited Ohio college or university in the Civil Engineering, Architecture and Planning field(s), and demonstrate strong community involvement.

Mr. Hogan was a strong advocate for educating more young African Americans about careers in lobbying. Through his involvement with the 100 Black Men of Central Ohio, he provided mentoring on government affairs. He received numerous accolades, awards, and commendations and served many organizations, including Maryhaven, Alvis House, Muscular Dystrophy Association, and the Columbus Metropolitan Area Community Action Organization.

It is with Ed Hogan's philosophy of advocating for the education of African American young people in mind that CT proudly sponsors a scholarship in his memory, with a focus on applicants who give back to their communities and peers.
