

The Minority Engineering Studies Scholarship



The Minority Engineering Studies Scholarship acknowledges the support from the Central Ohio National Society for Black Engineer Professionals and the Ohio Legislative Black Caucus. The purpose is to provide financial assistance to students of Black/African descent enrolled in a Civil Engineering, Architecture, Construction Management, Environmental Science, Landscape Architecture, Survey, or Urban Planning program at an accredited college or university.

- Two \$2,500 scholarships annually to a student of Black/African descent enrolled in a Civil Engineering, Architecture, Construction Management, Environmental Science, Landscape Architecture, Survey, Urban Planning, or related program at an accredited college or university.
- Renewable, upon reapplication by the student, for up to three academic years.
- Scholarship money is paid directly to the college or university prior to the start of the academic year.

We consider applications on a rolling basis. You are encouraged to have your application in by the end of May in order to be considered for awards the following September. The application is a multi-step process.
